












Vintage Year of Shut-In Wells – July 2020




GOR Changes in Returning Curtailed Wells




Monthly Completion Scenarios - Oil








Estimated Williston Basin Oil Transportation





Estimated ND Rail Export Volumes




Rail Destinations Market Share (June 2020)






Major Rail Lines and Refineries



Crude Oil Prices – Sep. 15, 2020




Williston Basin Truck/Rail Imports and Exports with Canada

Orange – % flared from wells with at least one mcf sold.






EIA Oil Price Forecast*




**EIA August 2020 SEO and January 2020 AEO Blend*




