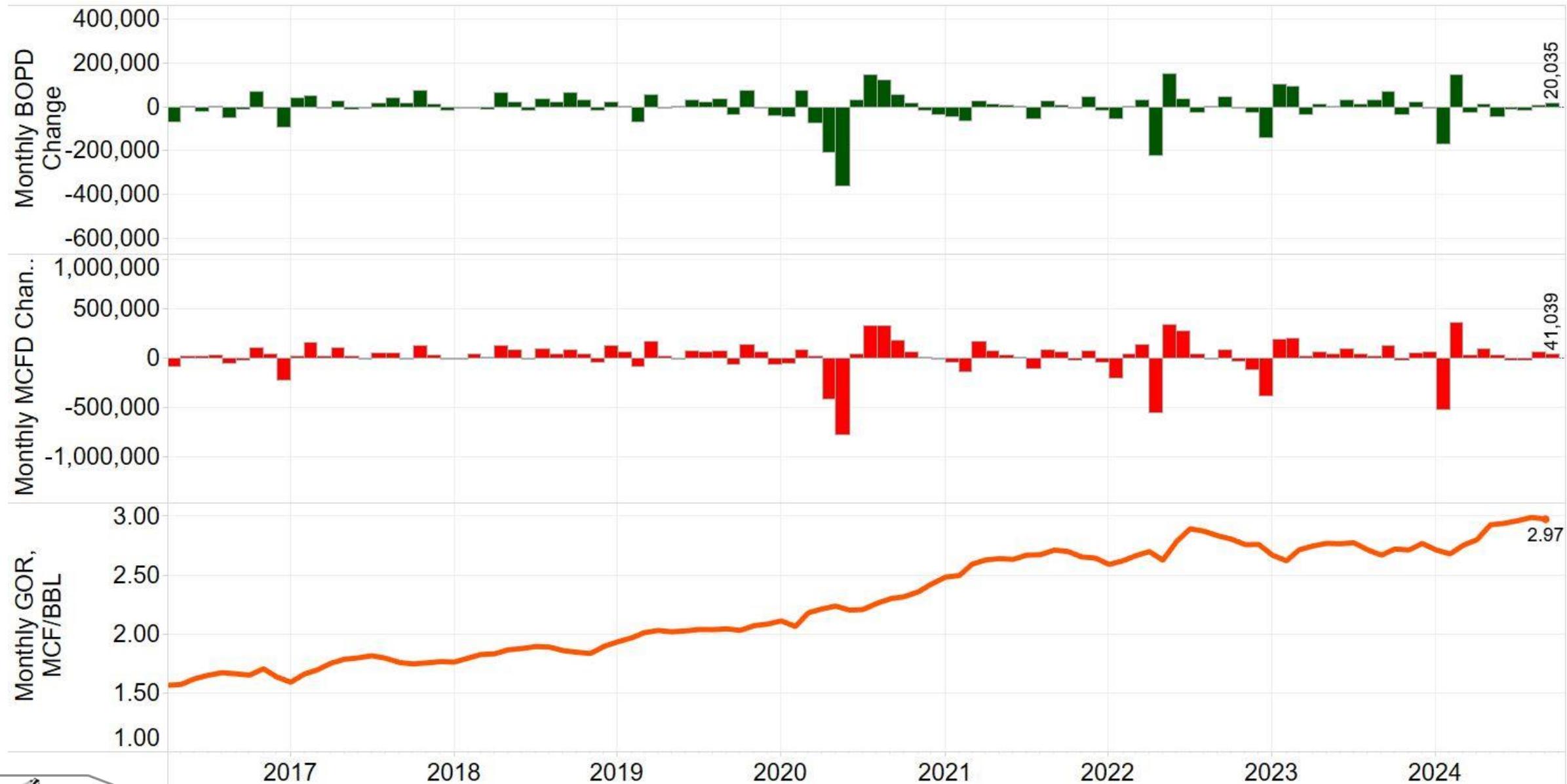



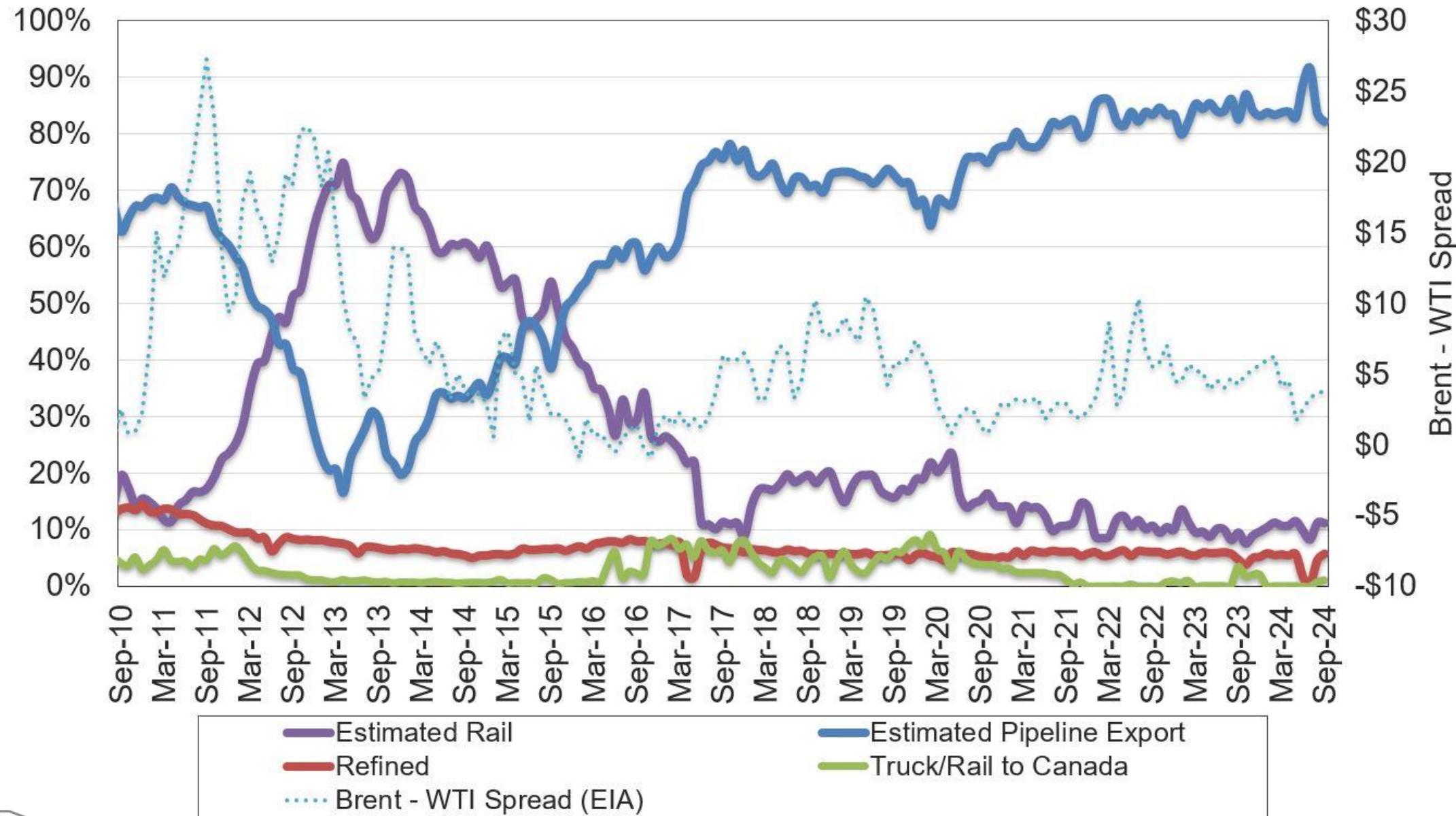

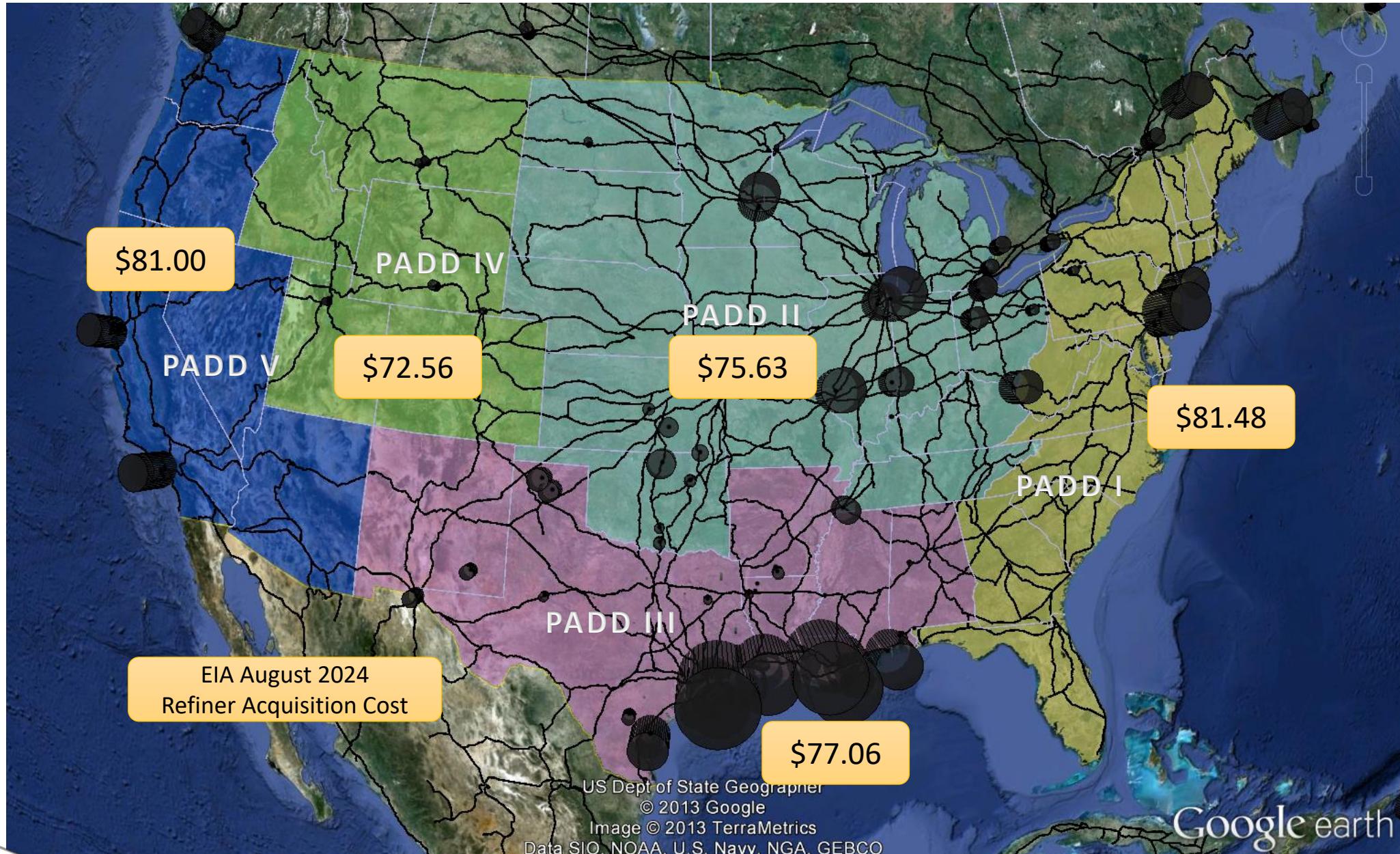

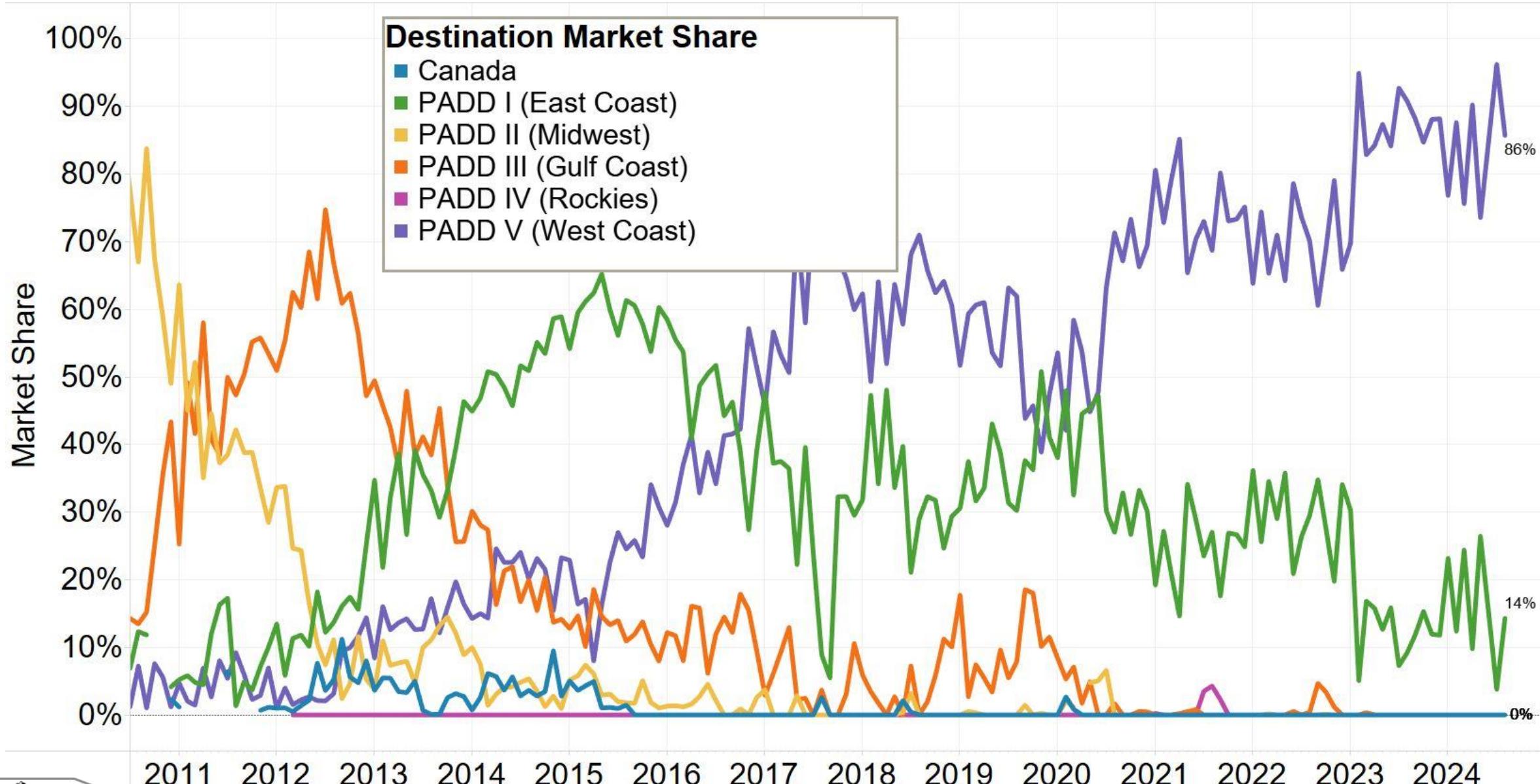
Estimated ND Rail Export Volumes



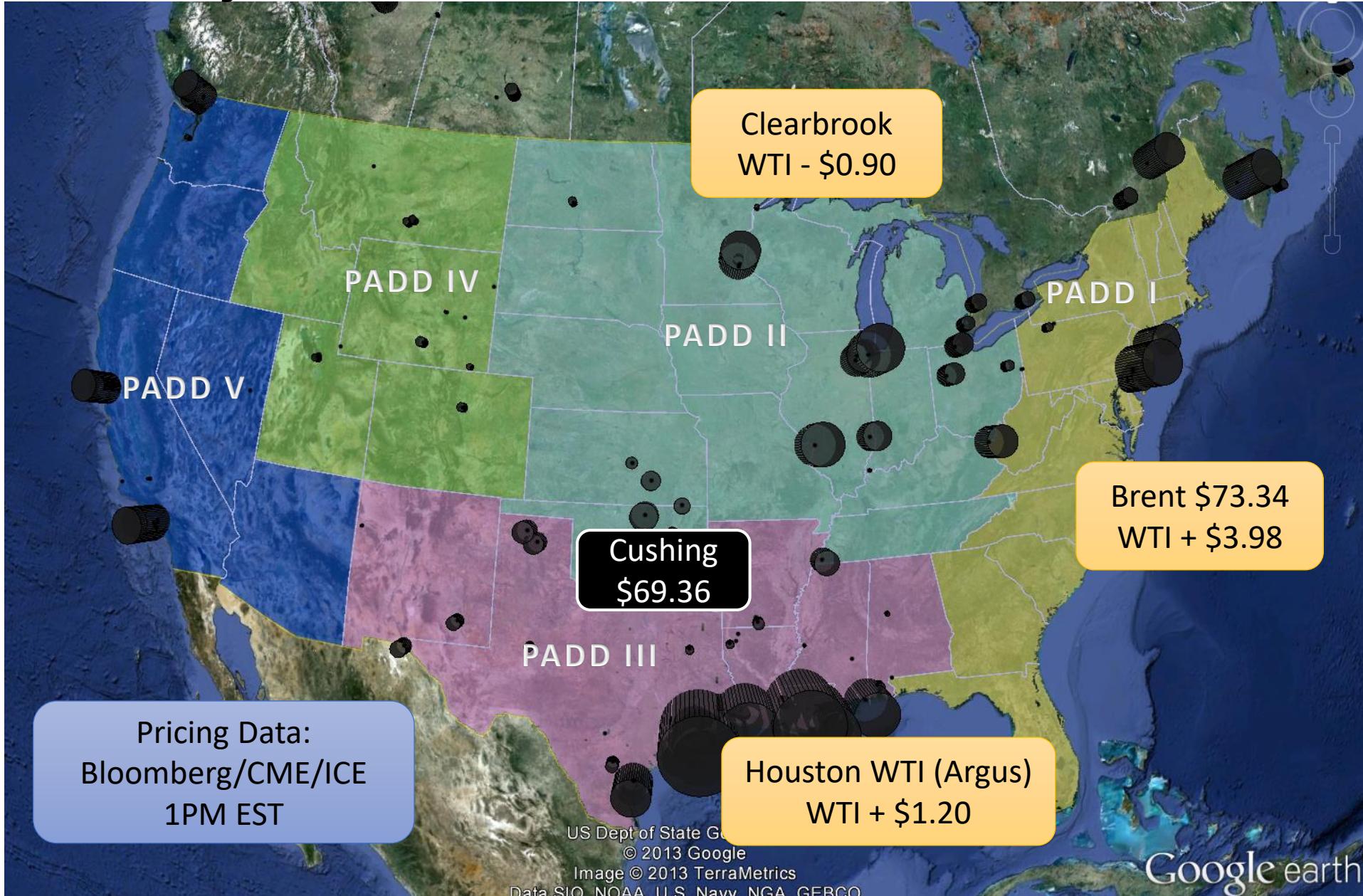
Major Rail Lines and Refineries



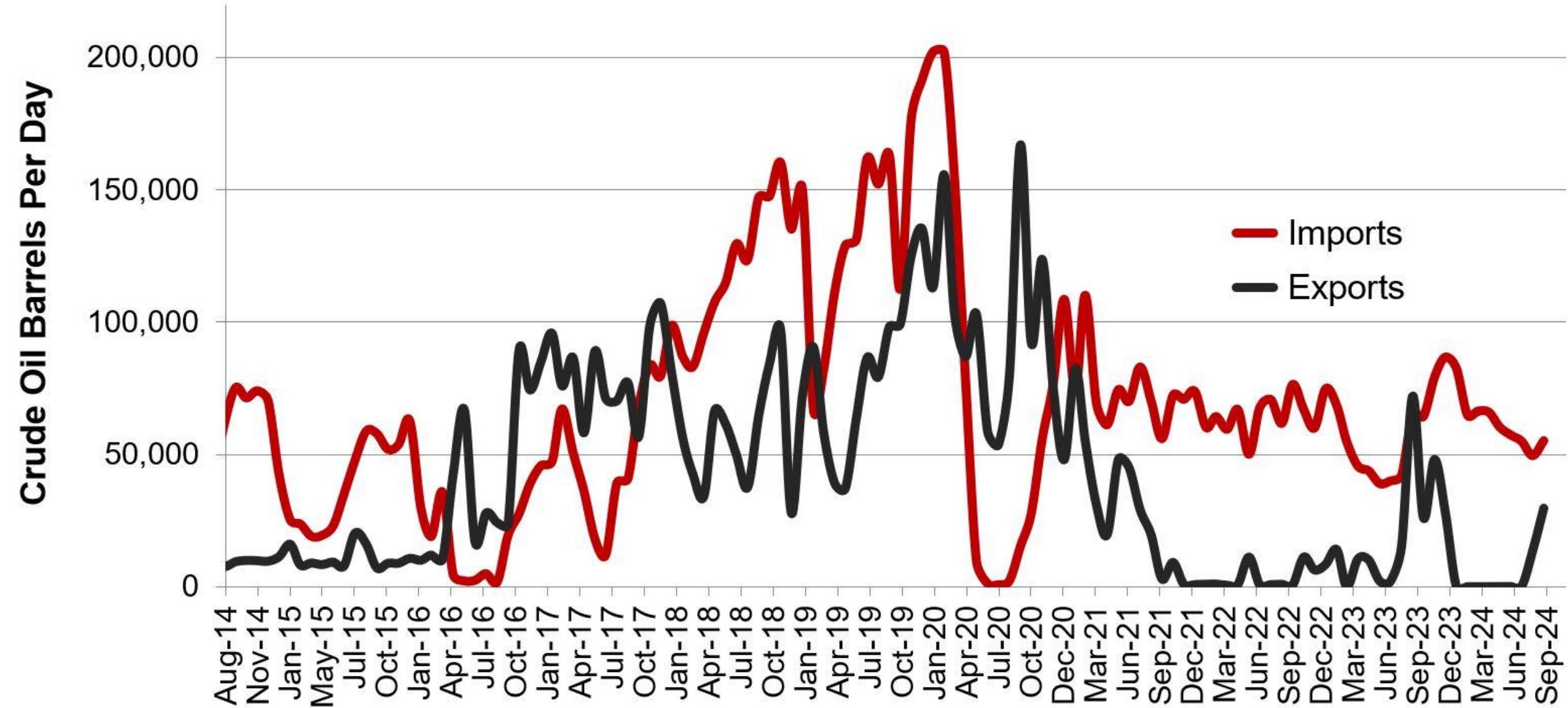
Rail Destinations Market Share (Aug. 2024)


Williston Basin Truck/Rail Imports and Exports with Canada


GREEN – % of gas captured and sold

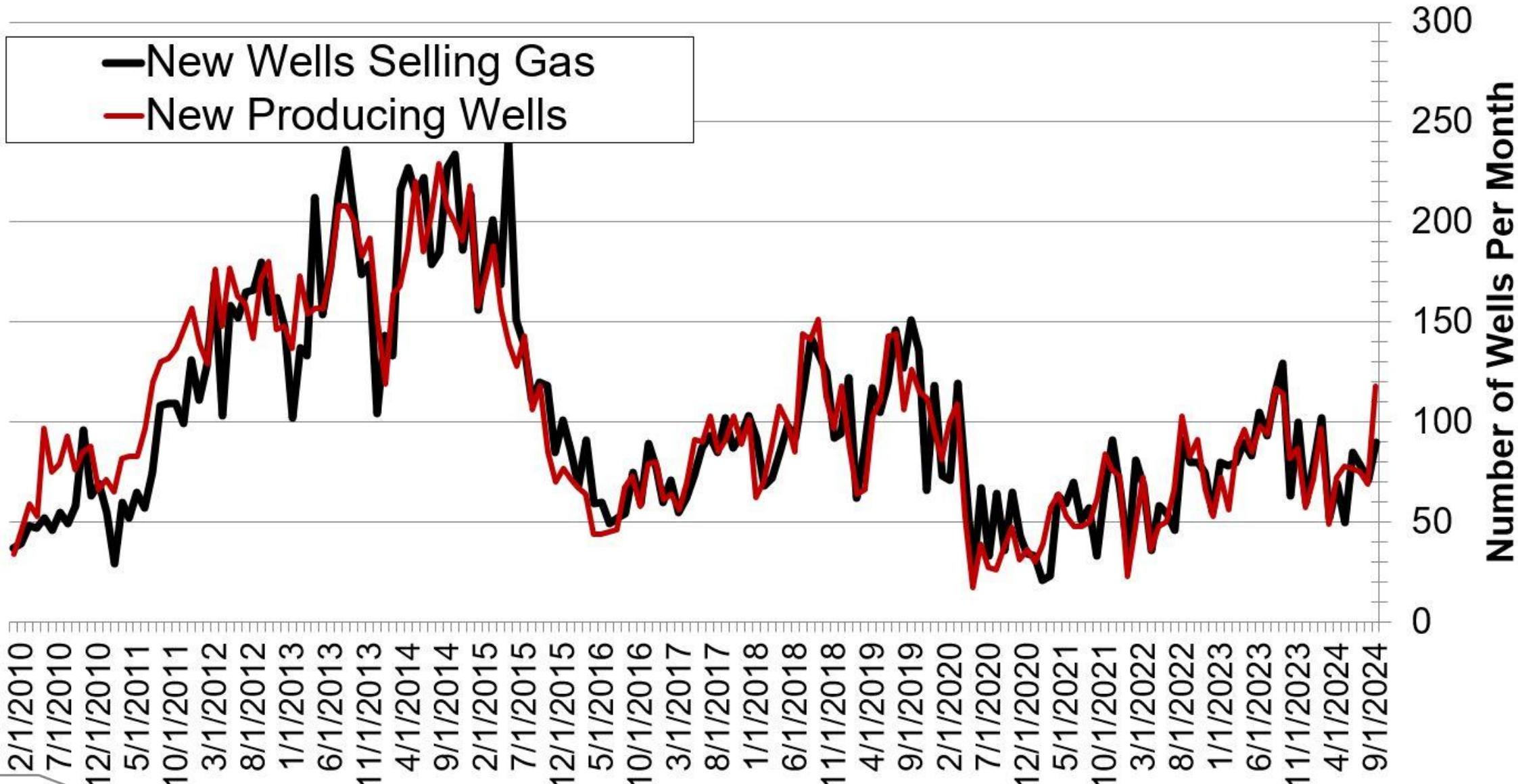
Blue – Lack of pipelines



EIA Oil Price Forecast: November 2024

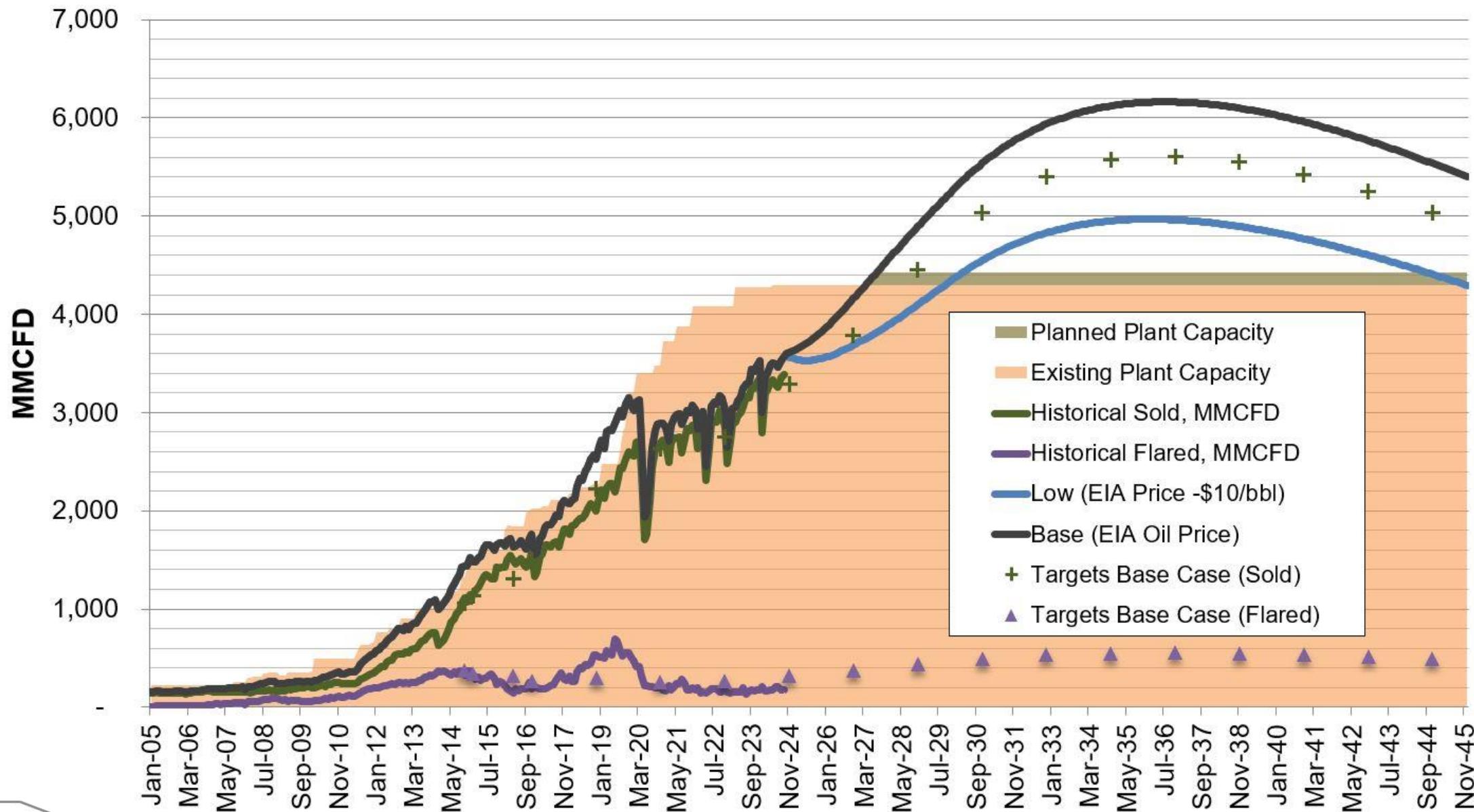
West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude oil price dollars per barrel



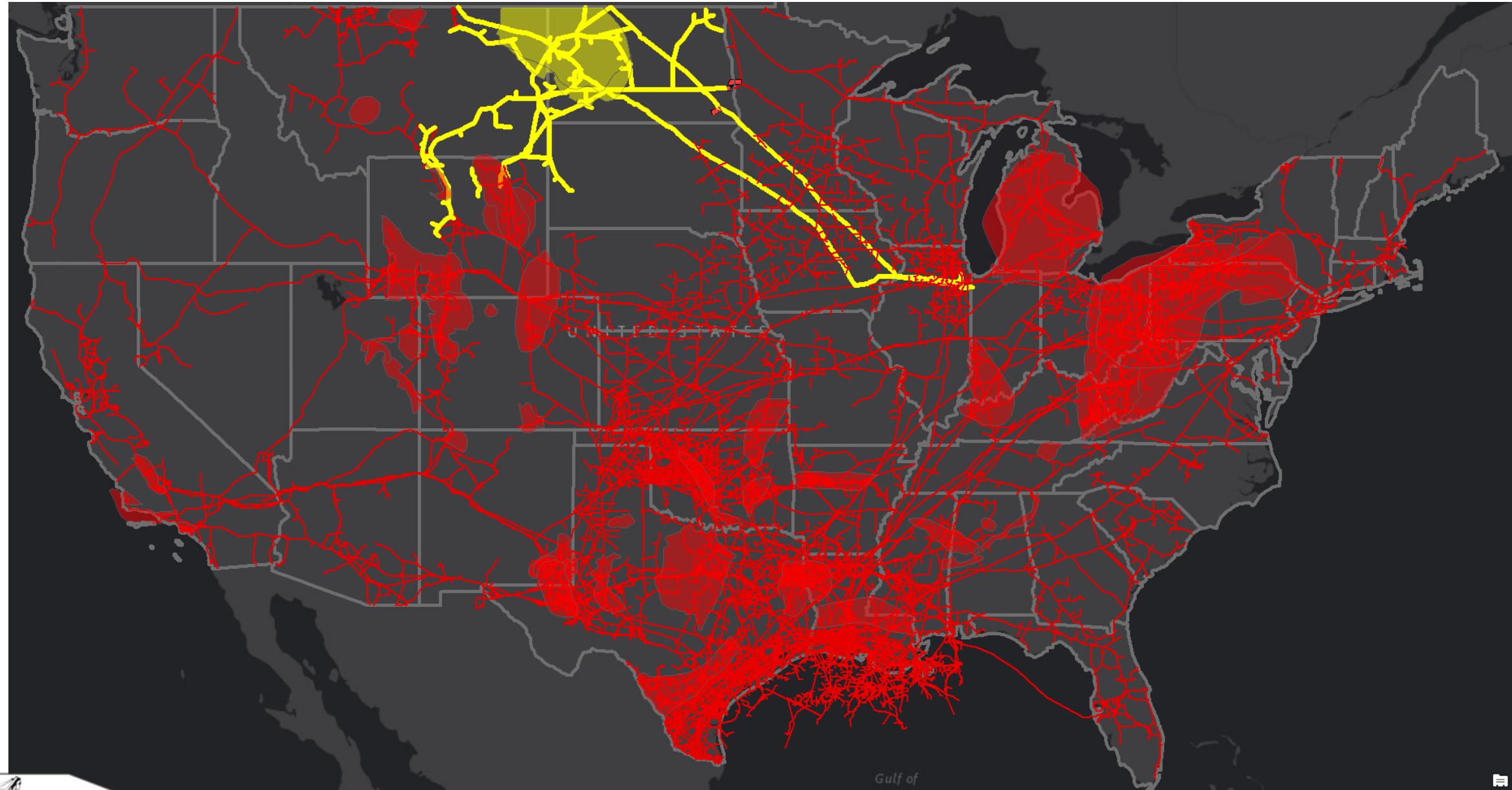

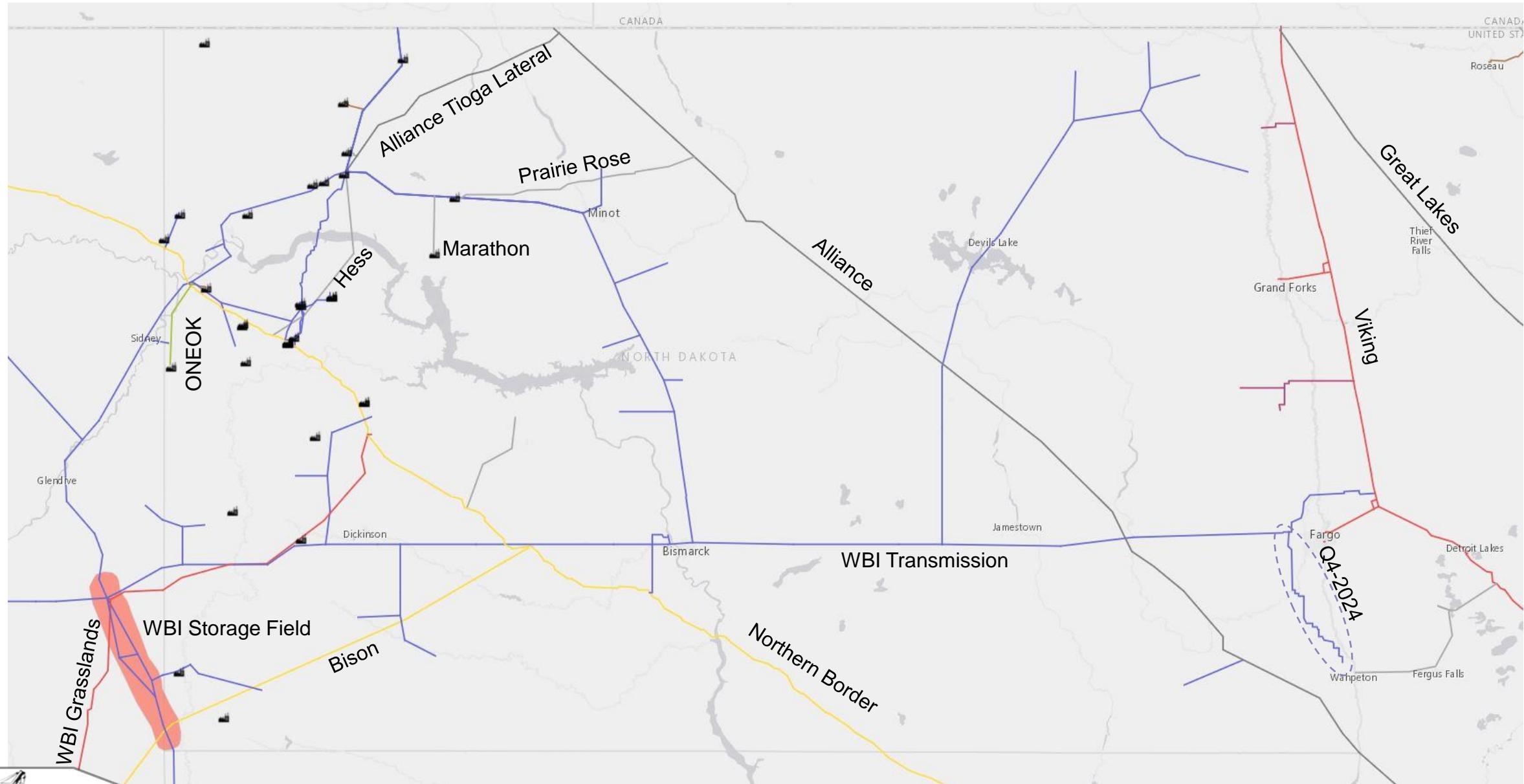
North Dakota Gas Processing Outlook




Bakken Natural Gas Infrastructure



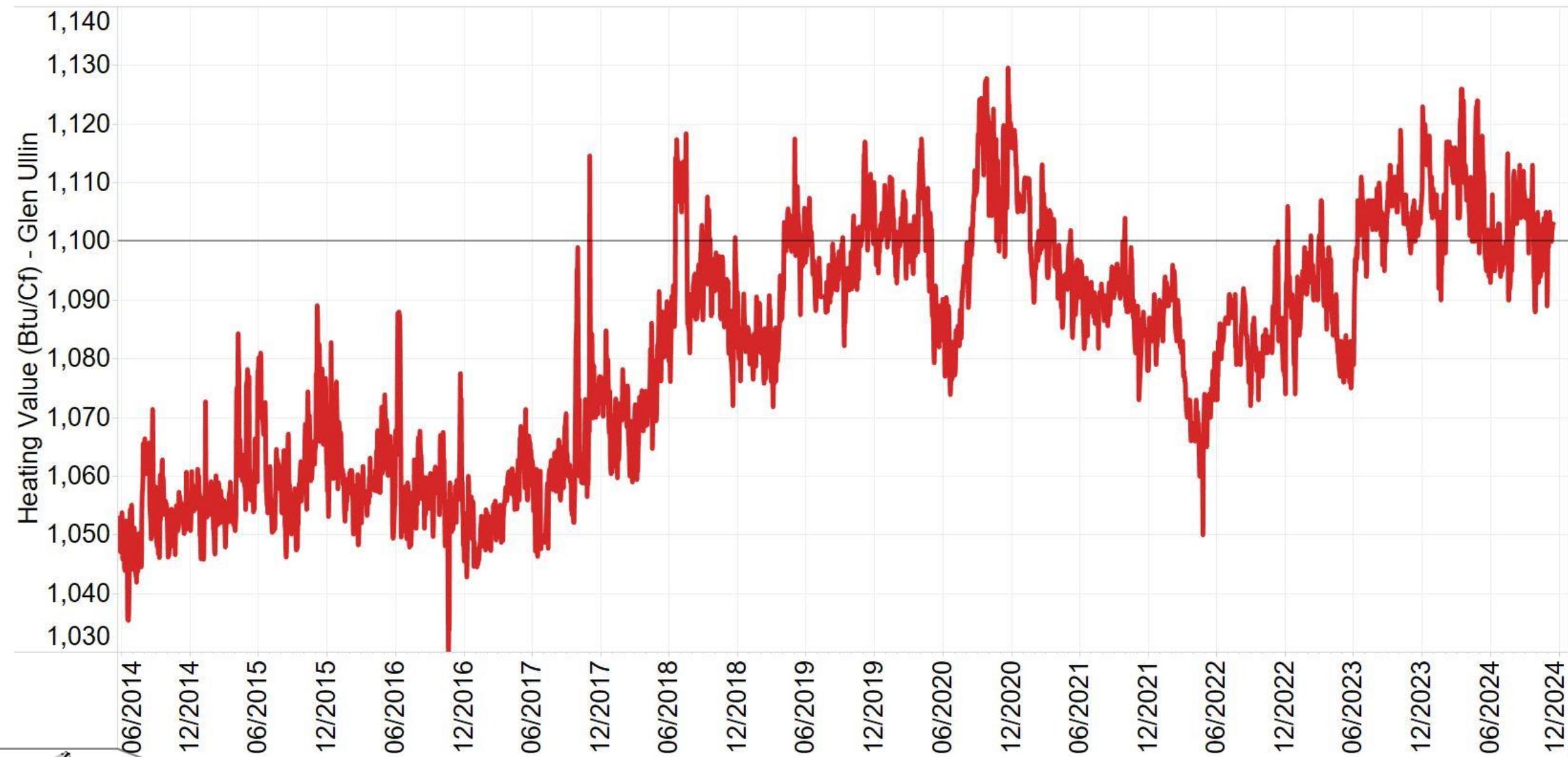
Major Residue Gas Pipeline Infrastructure
